AutoCAD is the most widely used drafting software among all companies worldwide. AutoCAD's tagline is "Nothing to paper, everything on the screen." As of 2019, there are approximately 11 million registered users and 3.5 million users of AutoCAD. History [edit] AutoCAD's roots go back to 1977, when a former worker at a Xerox business graphics lab conceived the idea of a graphics application that would run on a home computer. Released in 1982, AutoCAD was the first truly user-friendly computer-aided drafting software. Steve Silbergeld's inspiration came from a workstation he designed for the Xerox 8100 in 1977. The first version of the 8100 included a 6800 series IBM-compatible central processor, dual 8" monochrome CRTs, and a custom-designed 6-port display controller, using a chipset from Silicon

Graphics. The Xerox 7100, which followed, included a reduced feature set and was sold primarily to architects and engineers. The 8070, which is what Steve used, had been developed to aid in the design of the 7100 and was a major departure from earlier programs in both features and design. It included a mouse, built-in editing tools, and a simple object hierarchy for drawing. It included plans to add video support, but the 8070 was never released. Steve Silbergeld's original program had many shortcomings. It was very slow because the computer at the time could not perform most graphics calculations very fast, and the display monitor was not connected to the computer. To add to the frustration, he had to develop the entire application from scratch. The project was given the code name "Branton" and was officially named AutoCAD in June 1983, at Steve's suggestion. The entire work was done on a Xerox 7100 and was designed to display three-dimensional

(3-D) objects on a display monitor. The first version of AutoCAD was a 68K-based application. In 1985, as Apple began to compete with IBM, Autodesk began to move AutoCAD to a Macintosh platform, intending for it to take over a significant portion of the Apple Macintosh market. The first version of AutoCAD released for the Macintosh was an Adobe System Inc. Macintosh Extended application. AutoCAD has been licensed to companies in every industry, including Apple, Google, Sony, and Microsoft. The earliest

latest operating systems have also added native support for cloud-based storage and remote desktop. Users can also use the service providers' remote desktop solutions to access and manage AutoCAD from any machine. History AutoCAD was originally created by Mr. Brian Harry. The first version of AutoCAD was released in 1989. The software company 3D Realms bought AutoCAD and started re-branding it as 3D Studio Max and developed it into a full-blown 3D modeling package. 3D Realms sold it to Autodesk in 1999, and the product was re-branded as AutoCAD and updated several times per year. The most recent version is AutoCAD 2020 released in December 2013. In 2013, Autodesk announced AutoCAD 3D Concept Design by Autodesk Immersive Technology (ADIT), a cloud-based 3D design collaboration system designed to give customers greater control over their designs, and experience. Autodesk discontinued support for ADIT
